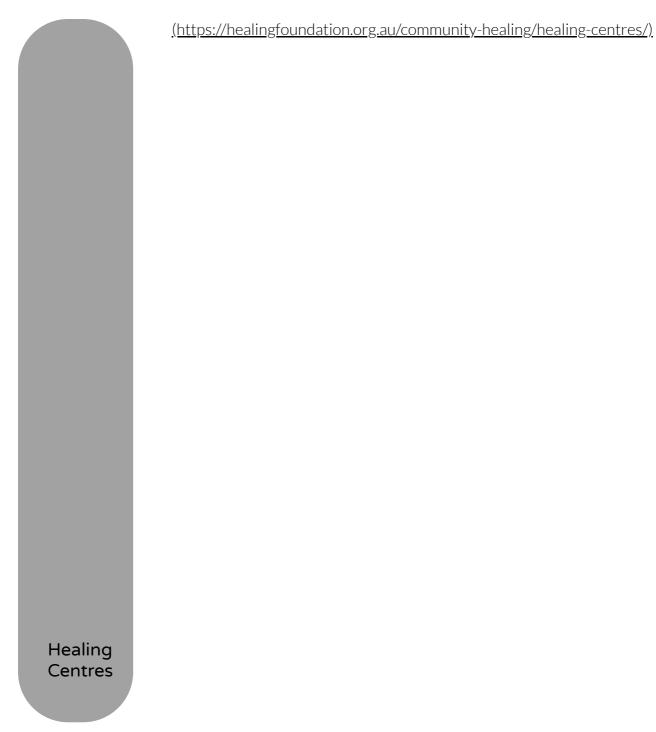

For the Healing Foundation, community healing involves supporting local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander organisations and individuals to design and deliver healing programs that meet the needs of their communities.

#### This includes:

- providing education and training to build the capacity of workers and communities to respond to trauma
- identifying the healing needs and priorities of different communities through healing forums.
- developing a business case for and supporting the establishment of healing centres around Australia
- recognising the importance of running separate men's healing and women's healing programs.

In December 2014, the Healing Foundation provided the first ever opportunity for Aboriginal men from the Darwin Town Communities to come together and discuss how harmony and balance could be restored in their communities. With the ongoing support of the Healing Foundation and our project partner, the Darwin Aboriginal and Islander Women's Shelter Indigenous Men's Service, the men have since formed a leadership group to advocate for the town communities and develop an employment strategy for the communities, among other initiatives.
