I, Tina Cleary, state: -

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. My full name is Tina Cleary.
- 1.2. I am the daughter of Patrick Cleary. My father was born in 1938.
- 1.3. I am providing this statement on behalf of my father who recently passed away on 19 July 2020, aged 82.
- 1.4. On 17 April 2019, I attended my father's private session with the Commission as his support person when he gave his account of the abuse he suffered.

2. THE ABUSE

- 2.1. My father suffered abuse when he was age 13 in 1951 as a third form boarding student attending Saint Patrick's Secondary School located at Silverstream, Upper Hutt.
- 2.2. The abuse was perpetrated over four years by Father Francis Durning and Father Patrick Minto. My father set out detail of the abuse he suffered in a written statement he has previously provided to the Commission.
- 2.3. My father's written statement to the Commission is dated 1 August 2018. My father's wish was that I read his statement at the hearing. I will read his statement.
